1. Nutrition and Dietetics Technologist (1 Post)

The intern will work under supervision in performing the following duties:

- Maintenance and safekeeping of laboratory equipment
- Guide trainees during practical training sessions.
- Supervise preparation of special menus.
- Requisition of practical training and assessment materials.
- Any other relevant duty assigned by the head of department.

Requirements: The applicant should:

- Have graduated with a diploma/ Level 6 in Community Nutrition/Nutrition and Dietetics/Clinical Nutrition from a recognized institution.
- Must be registered and have a current practicing license with the Kenya Nutritionists and Dietetics Institute (KNDI)
